01 / AEVONIX RESEARCH



Spectrum. The AE combines amber, coral and teal. Use the primary signature when the full company name is needed.

02 / PACOMIND



Stepped. The cream P is paired with interrupted teal and amber returns. The supplied wordmark is uppercase; write PacoMind in running text.

ONE INK

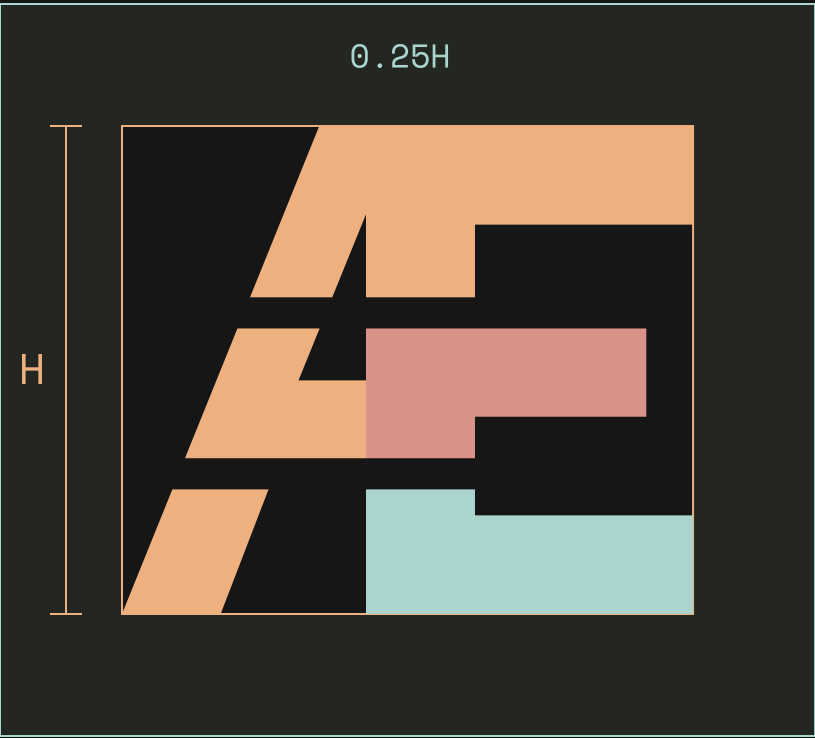


Use black or white artwork when color reproduction is unavailable. Keep all cutouts and returns intact.

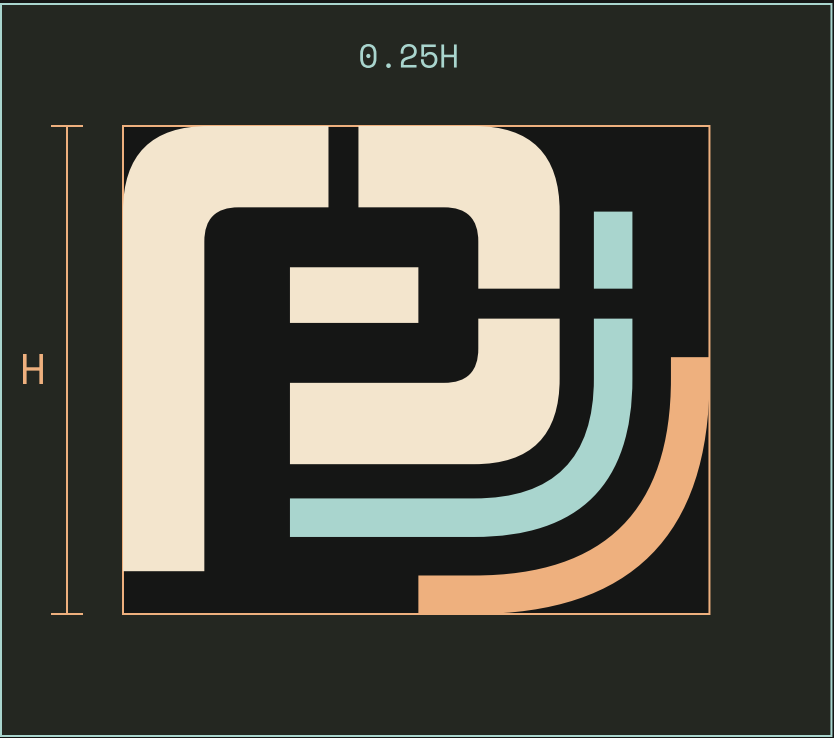
Space and size

Measure clear space from visible artwork, not from the SVG canvas.

Let H be the visible symbol height. Keep at least 0.25H clear around the entire logo, including the wordmark and the Research descriptor. The exported canvas padding is not a substitute for this space.

Typography and presentation

Keep the identity crisp within the instrument and CRT visual theme.

LOGO LETTERING

The logo lettering is based on Archivo with custom stencil openings. Use the supplied outlined artwork; do not retype or reconstruct it.

WEBSITE TYPE

The website uses Geist for headings and body copy, and Geist Mono for labels and numerical details.

GUIDE CAPTIONS

Space Mono is used for captions in the downloadable vector guide. Font source files carry their own licenses.

Composition	Use graphite or cream fields, simple panel divisions and measured spacing. Give the headline and body copy a clear reading order.
Artwork	Keep the logo static and proportional. Do not stretch, crop, rotate, outline or rebuild the mark or lettering.
Effects	Do not add gradients, shadows, glow or new colors to the artwork. Place scanlines, grids and instrument details around it, with enough contrast to keep the logo clear.
Motion	Animate the surrounding interface or demonstrations. Respect the operating system’s reduced-motion preference. Do not make content depend on movement.
Co-branding	Keep at least 0.5H between visible logos: twice the 0.25H clear space, measured using the larger mark. Avoid layouts or wording that imply an endorsement.

AEVONIX RESEARCH

Aevonix Research develops local agentic systems and incubates AI projects. Its ongoing research toward PAGI (Pseudo-AGI), including PacoMind, is open source. Aevonix works with OEMs and resellers to help customers gain priority access to HPC equipment it sells, and supports datacenter placement, cluster management and monetization through its partners and network. It is launching HPC investment SPVs in 2027.

PACOMIND

PacoMind is an ongoing, open source research project from Aevonix Research. Built for Hermes, it stores agent memory, identity and shared work independently of the models it uses and supports local inference. PacoMind is part of the lab’s work toward PAGI (Pseudo-AGI).

MARC SEAL / FOUNDER

Marc Seal is the founder of Aevonix Research. His background includes work at The Topps Company and advising The Walt Disney Company on emerging technologies. His writing covers AI policy and compute infrastructure.

ADDITIONAL FACTS

Research: PacoMind and PAGI research are open source and ongoing. Aevonix supports the pursuit of open access to AGI.

HPC services: Equipment sales, priority access through OEMs and resellers, datacenter placement, cluster management and monetization through partners.

Deployments: Aevonix has supported several NVIDIA B300 deployments across Central America and the United States.

Investment program: HPC investment SPVs are launching in 2027.

SVG	Editable filled vector paths. Use for websites, layout tools and scale-independent artwork.
PDF	Vector logos and a six-page guide. Supply to print and publishing workflows.
PNG	Transparent signatures at 1600 px wide; symbols at 1024 px; small icons and 512 px avatars.
Color files	CSS custom properties, structured JSON and a GIMP/Inkscape palette. All values are RGB.
Source	Authored geometry, build script, pinned dependencies and original fonts with their own license notices.
